AEC2021 OVERVIEW

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) estimates that Africa will need \$1.2 trillion over the next three years to recover from the pandemic. Furthermore, if proactive measures are not taken to salvage the situation, the IMF predicts that an additional 43 million Africans might be pushed into poverty.

In our bid to achieve and sustain post-pandemic recovery, economic fragility remains a pressing concern for Africa. Africa hosts 30% of the world's mineral reserves, possesses 60 percent of the world's arable land, 13 percent of the global population, and is the most youthful continent with about 60 percent of its population under the age of 25 well as abundant as energy potentials.
